## Net Zero GHG Emissions

We have made a commitment to be a net zero organisation by 2050. We will achieve this by pursuing an ambitious 1.5°C aligned science-based target for our full value chain emissions and compensating residual hard-to-decarbonise emissions with certified greenhouse gas removal.



### Strategy

We are committed to making a meaningful contribution to the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). SDG13 requires us to take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts, including reducing emissions to align with global commitments.

To achieve net zero emissions in our operations by 2050 we will:

- Reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 30% by 2028 from a 2023 base year.
- Reduce scope 3 GHG emissions 30% by 2028 from 2023 base year.
- From 2035 compensate for other residual hard-to-decarbonise emissions with high quality certified greenhouse gas removal.
- Commit to carbon emissions savings to achieve net zero by 2050 (NT44).
- Contribute to certified carbon offset funds (compliant with UKGBC guidance) (NT64).
- Achieve or aim to achieve carbon certification (independently verified) (NT45).
- Implement a fleet emissions monitoring programme on each contract, including data collection (miles, type of vehicle, engine type, emissions standard) (NT66).

## Implementation

Every part of West Wallasey has a role to play in our becoming a net zero organisation.

- We will develop our GHG Management Plan which will identify targets for Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions, priorities for action, investment, governance and reporting.
- We will increase the proportion of renewable energy consumed in our workplaces and in powering our vehicle fleet.
- We will increase the proportion of electric and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles on our fleet.
- We will review our purchasing practices to reduce consumption, and in particular consumption of fossil fuels such as petrol and diesel, and we will operate proactively to minimise waste.
- We will consult and will work constructively with our customers and our partners to proactively transition their operational vehicle fleets to electric and hydrogen fuel cell technologies.
- We will establish a carbon off-set fund to purchase high quality certified offsets at market rates and accelerate our own and others' efforts to decarbonise.
- We will consider alternative working practices, review our vehicle delivery strategy, and provide information and support to employees on sustainable transport options to and from our places of work.
- We will comply with the reporting requirements of the Science Based Target initiative.
- We will communicate our progress to our customers, suppliers, employees, and other stakeholders via our Annual Report.
- We will integrate our carbon reduction plans through the application of our Environmental & Sustainability Policy, our Environmental Management Systems certified to ISO14001 and our Energy Management Systems certified to ISO50001.



## Governance

This statement is made on behalf of the West Wallasey board in line with the policies that it sets and is implemented across all West Wallasey operations through rules, procedures, and guidance. It is reviewed and approved annually, or more frequently if appropriate.
